INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON THE QUARTERLY AND YEAR TO DATE FINANCIAL RESULTS:

To the Board of Directors of M/s. Arihant's Securities Limited

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of Arihant's Securities Limited for the quarter ended 31st March, 2023 and the year to date results for the period 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 & 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulation").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, these standalone financial results:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 & 52 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit for the year ended 31st March, 2023 and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended 31st March, 2023 as well as the year to date results for the period from 1st April, 2022 to 31st March, 2023.

Basis for Opinion
